How to get there:

By plane

There are flights to and from Istanbul and Ankara to the closest airport, Adana Sakirpasa Airport. There are shuttles from the airport to Mersin. Also it is possible to take a train to Mersin from Adana. Adana – Mersin 85km

By bus

There is a bus station in eastern part of the city. There are city buses running between the city center and the bus station. Usually each bus company has its own shuttles running between the city center, western (coastal part) and the bus station.

From the bus station there are buses to almost every city in Turkey and to small cities and villages in Cilician Mountains (the rest of Mersin Province), including buses from Gaziantep (5hrs).
